## FURTHER PROGRAMME STRUCTURE DESCRIPTION

Each course normally extends over not more than one (1) semester, but in some cases may extend over two (2) semesters.

In order to be eligible for the award of the associate degree, candidates must have obtained passes in courses equivalent to a minimum of one hundred and twenty-five (125) credits from Levels I, II and III, as follows:
