Students may also access one semester courses of their choice from any Associate Degree programme and obtain credits.

PRE-COLLEGE PROGRAMME

The following is the Structure of Pre-College Programme:

Pre-College 1: This is for those who have not been exposed to CSEC/external examination syllabus. It includes the following General Basic Subjects:

- Mathematics, English, TCI Studies, Computer Studies and two others from the area of specialization. Students enrolled in Pre-College 1 must continue to Pre-College 2

Pre-College 2: This is for those who have been exposed to CSEC/external examination syllabus but have failed or do not meet the minimum entry requirement for the Associate degree programmes. It includes the following specialized subjects:

- English, Mathematics and three others.

NOTE: Classes can ONLY proceed with a COHORT of a minimum of 5 Students.

ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must satisfy the following minimum requirements:

For the Associate Degree: Five GCE or CXC subjects including English A and Mathematics at the General Proficiency Level with Grads I, II, and III or GCE Grades A, B, C. Students without CXC/GCE Mathematics and English must complete the College Foundation Math: MTH1110 and MTH1120, and ENG1111 and ENG1122 (at additional cost)

For the Certificate Programmes: Three GCE or CXC subjects, one of which must be English at General Proficiency level 1, 11, & 111 or GCE Grades A, B, C.

For the Bachelor's Degree: An Associate Degree from the TCI Community College or another recognized institution.

Students applying through the Mature Student Entry policy should be twenty-one (21) years or older with relevant experience in specific areas of interest.

Note that students may be required to complete a Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR) portfolio.

The deadline for applications is Friday, June 4th, 2021. Any application received after this date would be deemed as LATE.

All applications should be fully completed **ONLINE** by visiting the college's website at <https://tcicc.edu.tc> and clicking on the green button that says “**Apply Now**” OR <https://isims.tcicc.edu.tc/apply/> Make sure to **scan** and **upload** all supporting documents with the application form. An application fee of \$25 should be paid at either the **Grand Turk Campus** OR the **Providenciales Campus**. Candidates can also pay to the College's **CIBC FirstCaribbean** account number: **1596776** and include names and what the payment is for – e.g. application, registration, tuition. They can then scan the receipt/teller and upload with application. Please provide this information to the Accounts Department for update. Late application fee is \$50.

COST OF PROGRAMMES/COURSES OFFERED BY THE TURKS AND CAICOS ISLANDS
COMMUNITY COLLEGE EFFECTIVE 27TH AUGUST 2018

A. SHORT COURSES

Courses are for fifteen days for two hours per day (except for AutoCAD, Automotive Maintenance & Surveying). Credits earned could be transferred into the College programmes.

Students may audit the courses and not participate in the examination. Students should indicate at the commencement of the course whether or not the course is being audited. No credit will be given for those courses which are audited.

B. ONE SEMESTER COURSES

Courses run from September – December; January – May; concentrated summer semester May – early July.

C. FULL TIME PROGRAMMES

Two years, two semesters per year for the majority of the programmes. Some programmes are for five semesters with compulsory summer courses during the first year. Additionally, students may access summer courses from May – early July.
